

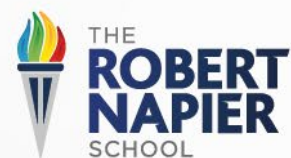

ADMISSIONS POLICY

The Trust's aims are to ensure that all children within our schools gain a first-rate education, develop the skills necessary for the next stage in their lives and are equipped with the personal values and attributes that will make them successful in a fast changing world.

Under the terms of the funding agreements with the Secretary of State, the Beyond Schools Trust is the admissions authority for all schools within the Trust. The Trust will comply with the School Admissions and School Admissions Appeals Codes, as published by the Department for Education. The Trust will join in any Admissions Forum, coordinated admission arrangements and Fair Access Protocol that the appropriate authority might operate. The Trust expects that all schools in the Trust will ensure that their admissions arrangements, oversubscription criteria and admission number are considered (and consulted on if necessary) annually.

The Trust will make arrangements for an Independent Appeals Panel, properly trained and clerked should the need arise.

Diversity (equality) impact assessment. Admission arrangements and oversubscription criteria will be considered annually in order to address any adverse impact on prospective pupils.

Monitoring arrangements – LOCAL GOVERNING BODY will annually monitor arrangements, oversubscription criteria and admission numbers and if necessary conduct a consultation on any suggested changes or after seven years.
